## City of Toronto's Participatory Budgeting Pilot Project

- Ward 33
- Oakridge
- Rustic

- Worked with City of Toronto staff to conduct youth-friendly outreach
- Hosted youth-only workshops and town halls on the project to brainstorm ideas
- Empowered youth leaders to own PB
- Youth ideas made it onto the ballot and were eventually voted for



## 2018 City Budget

- 100,000 households waiting for social housing
- 1 in 4 children live in poverty (1 in 3 in some parts of the city)
- Waitlists for affordable recreation have grown by 62%to 189,000

- "Kicking the can down the road"
- Growing inequality
- \$66M in unfunded promises (adopted strategies)
- Who will this city and its budgets be affordable for if we continue down this road?




